ITINERARY:



DAY 01 12/nov BUENOS AIRES

Welcome to Argentina! Reception at Buenos Aires International Airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation and rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 02 13/nov BUENOS AIRES - CITY TOUR + ROJO TANGO (HOTEL FAENA) W/ DINNER

Breakfast at the hotel. We will start our panoramic City Tour covering the main tourist attractions in the city. Starting from the north, we will continue to the Retiro, Recoleta and Palermo quarters. Soon we will enter the city center visiting the Teatro Colón, Obelisco and Plaza de la República, Plaza de Mayo with Metropolitan Cathedral, the Cabildo and the Casa Rosada. We will continue our tour to the neighborhood of La Boca where football, tango and art in color are the protagonists. The panoramic tour continues, covering the most famous gastronomic area of the city: Puerto Madero. Return to the hotel.

In the evening, departure from the hotel to a tango show with dinner included. After the show, transfer back to the hotel.

Open every day at the Hotel Cabaret del Faena, the hotel was designed by Philippe Starck and is recognized, among other details, for its services and sophisticated environments. The show's proposal is developed in a very intimate place that represents a Buenos Aires cabaret in 1900, with limited capacity and an exclusive profile, we are able to provide the audience an intense tango experience, with the proximity and movement of dancers, singers and a live orchestra at Cabaret.

Rojo Pasión: A cabaret with the touch of Philippe Starck, created to relive the nostalgia of an era that was, with the strength of a phenomenon today, of fantasies and sensuality.

Rojo Sabor: A gastronomic proposal with its own character, which favors the subtlety of perfumes and textures, accompanied by the delicate style of Baron B champagne.

Rojo Tango: Tango has been used as an intense reality, through a different live show, in which the bodies must be guided by what the band says and explodes in an unquestionable ecstasy of pleasure.

**DAY 03 14/nov BUENOS AIRES / COLÔNIA DEL SACRAMENTO/ BUENOS AIRES
(BUQUEBUS)**

Free day at leisure.

Optional tour - Crossing the De la Plata river by speed boat from Buenos Aires to Colonia del Sacramento (Uruguay)



DAY 04 15/nov BUENOS AIRES / USHUAIA

Transfer to Buenos Aires Airport to board a flight to Ushuaia. Reception at the airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation and rest of the day at leisure.

**DAY 05 16/nov USHUAIA - TIERRA DEL FUEGO NATIONAL PARK WITH TRAIN "DEL
FIN DEL MUNDO" + NAVIGATION BEAGLE CHANNEL**

In the morning, departure towards the last road in the world (the southernmost road) through a wonderful park full of woods, beaches and lakes. When we arrive at the Tierra del Fuego National Park, we will take the End of the World Train (included): made by the colonizers of Ushuaia, it connected the prison, now a museum, to the area where today is the national park. The former prisoners climbed on the small train and collected firewood to supply the prison's heaters. This small train was converted into a touristic train and today its journey lasts approximately 45 minutes inside the park. A journey through time. Visit to Lapataia Bay, where we find beaver colonies and we will have the opportunity to take light walks within the park. After the tour, we return to Ushuaia.

In the afternoon, you will take a catamaran cruise along the Beagle Channel that separates Ushuaia from the Chilean islands. The catamaran provides a beautiful view of the city, the Martial mountain range, and will stop at the Eclair lighthouse, on Isla de los Lobos Mariños and on Isla de los Cormoranes. Return to the hotel early in the evening.

DAY 06 17/nov USHUAIA / EL CALAFATE

Transfer to Ushuaia Airport to board a flight to El Calafate. Reception at the airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation and rest of the day at leisure.



**DAY 07 18/nov EL CALAFATE - LOS GLACIARES NATIONAL PARK: PERITO MORENO
GLACIER WITH NAUTICAL SAFARI**

Departure from the hotel in El Calafate towards Los Glaciares National Park. Along the way, stops for taking pictures of the beautiful panoramic views of Lake Argentino, the Andes Mountains and snowy peaks. Embark on a navigation of approximately 1 hour seeing the Perito Moreno glacier from Brazo Rico, an excursion known as Nautical Safari that allows you to have spectacular views from the water level. Continue to the observation walkways of the Perito Moreno glacier, where you can admire it from different angles. At a scheduled time (approx. 3:00 pm), return to the hotel in El Calafate.

**OPTIONAL => ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENT - LOS GLACIARES NATIONAL PARK: MINI TREKKING
PERITO MORENO:: ADITONAL € 150 PER PERSON**

“In the morning, transfer from the Hotel in El Calafate to the port located in the 'Bajo de las sombra' bay, approximately 6 km away before reaching the Mirador del Glaciar, where you embark to cross Lake Rico, reaching the southwest coast, approximately 20 minutes before arriving at the Glacier. We will take a short trail through the woods until we reach the banks of the ice where our guides will place the staples on the participants, who will receive instructions on how they should behave on the ice. The journey over the glacier lasts approximately 2 hours and, during the course of it, you will be able to appreciate a variety of ice formations such as: cracks, small lagoons, waterfalls, sinks etc. The walk is moderate. The surface of the ice on which you walk is irregular but firm and safe. We will receive explanations about the flora, fauna and general glaciology of the region as well as the particular phenomenon that occurs at the Perito Moreno Glacier and eventually produces its rupture. At the end of the tour, you return to the refuge through the lush Magellanic forest. A vehicle is available for the transfer from Calafate to anyone who wants to return directly to Calafate or we recommend staying another hour to visit the Mirador do Glaciar and its walkways. All services are carried out daily and have permanent assistance from mountain guides on the glacier where the activity of hiking on the ice takes place. (This tour has a moderate degree of physical difficulty, being allowed for people between 10 and 65 years of age. It is not advisable for overweight people and prohibited for pregnant women, people who suffer from diseases with risk of worsening in case of walking and people with motor and functional problems).”

DAY 08 19/nov EL CALAFATE / PUERTO NATALES

At the scheduled time, board a private vehicle to the city of Puerto Natales in Chile (the journey takes approximately 4:00 am). Accommodation and rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 09 20/nov PUERTO NATALES – TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

Depart on a regular excursion to the Torres del Paine National Park, one of the most beautiful in Chile. On the way, stop to visit Cueva del Milodon, a huge cave 50 meters high and 200 meters deep, where fossils of an extinct animal named Milodon were found. After the visit, continue the visit until reaching the entrance to the Park, the sector of Laguna Amarga. During the trip we will be able to observe several wild animals such as foxes, chicks (ostrich type), hares and guanacos. In the park we will visit the viewpoint of Torres, the viewpoint of Los Cuernos, the viewpoint Nordenshol, the Saltos Grande and Chico and the Gray lake. In the late afternoon, return to Puerto Natales. This tour already includes tickets to the park. After the tour, transfer back to the hotel.

DAY 10 21/nov PUERTO NATALES / PUNTA ARENAS

At the scheduled time, board a private vehicle to the city of Punta Arenas (the journey takes approximately 3:30 am). Accommodation and rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 11 22/nov PUNTA ARENAS / SANTIAGO

At the scheduled time, transfer to Punta Arenas Airport to board a flight to Santiago. Reception at Santiago Airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation and rest of the day at leisure.



DAY 12 23/nov SANTIAGO - PANORAMIC CITY TOUR + CONCHA Y TORO WINERY WITH WINE TASTING

After breakfast, departure from the hotel in Santiago to visit the main tourist attractions, starting with the historic center of the capital and ending with the modern buildings that emerge from the city. First of all, we will visit the city center starting with its main avenue, Avenida Libertador Bernardo O'Higgins, better known as Alameda, where you will visit the Presidential Palace La Moneda, a neoclassical building, named this way because it was there where they once coined the coins that circulated within the country. We will continue using the pedestrian walks in the center: Huérfanos and Ahumada, which bring together the largest commercial activity in the city and which lead to the Plaza de Armas, a strategic place from where the first routes of the city were made. Around it stands the Cathedral Church, the Central Post Office, and the Municipality of Santiago (City Hall). Soon we will visit the Santa Lucía hill, an important architectural site that represents a connotated place since it is the strategic point of the city's foundation. Then we will pass by Parque Forestal and the Museum of Fine Arts, with the Mapocho River on its side. We cross the river to

reach the Bellavista neighborhood, a well-known bohemian neighborhood that concentrates strong cultural, artistic and night activities. Finally the new city center, the Providencia commune and the Las Condes and Vitacura neighborhoods, protagonists of Santiago's growth and modernity.

In the afternoon, departure from the hotel in Santiago, heading south towards the city to approach a mountain range area. We will continue the journey to enter a well-known gorge known as the Cajón del Maipo, a peasant area in which the landscape of snowy mountains and small crops of vines combine. Driving through the valley, we will arrive to one of the most internationally renowned wineries: Concha y Toro. We will visit the private park and its plantations, using traditional wineries to reach a corner that keeps one of the secrets of the winery ... Casillero del Diablo. This visit is followed by a wine tasting and the glass used in it will be kept a souvenir of the experience. Time to buy wine at the winery shop. Return to the hotel in Santiago.

DAY 13 24/nov SANTIAGO - VIÑA DEL MAR & VALPARAISO

We will start our experience from the hotel in Santiago towards the Pacific Coast, crossing the fertile Curacaví and Casablanca valleys, recognizing the latter for its production of white wines. Traveled along the coastal path, visit the city of Valparaíso from the lookouts located on any of the 43 hills that surround the bay and its curious elevators called "Ascensores". The historic center of this port city has been declared a World Heritage Site, its architecture gives it a marked personality and highlights its tourist attraction. View of its historic, commercial areas and the National Congress. We will climb one of the most famous lifts in the city. Later, we will visit Cerro Alegre and have an extraordinary visit from the Paseo Yugoslavo. We will continue walking to Cerro Concepción and visit the picturesque Atkinson Walk, getting one of the best postcards of Valparaíso. The Nobel Prize for Literature, Pablo Neruda, opened his La Sebastiana house more than 50 years ago on one of the hills of Valparaíso and today it is a museum and cultural house. We will continue the tour to the neighboring seaside town, Viña del Mar, famous for its gardens, the Flower Clock which is its symbol, the Games Casino and the main avenues and gardens of the coastal sector. Soon we will continue through residential sectors of modern architecture, arriving at the beach of Reñaca. Lunch not included. In the middle of the afternoon we will return through the center of Viña Del Mar, Praça Vergara and Avenida Alvares to take the road back to Santiago. Return to the hotel.

DAY 14 25/nov SANTIAGO

Free day fat leisure.

OPTIONAL TOUR => SANTA RITA WINERY WITH LUNCH: € 170 PER PERSON

"Transfer from the hotel to the winery. On the way to the top of Jahuel, where you will find the famous Santa Rita vineyard. La Viña was founded in 1880 by Domingo Fernández Concha, who introduced fine French lines from his world-renowned wines. Its winery, its patron's house and the park around it, were declared National Monuments (MN). We will stop at the house called Dona Paula, in honor of Dona Paula Jaraquemada, where we'll have lunch. At that time, this place was the scene of several historical events related to the Independence of Chile. General Bernardo O'Higgins calls to fight the Spanish crown, taking refuge with 120 of his soldiers. And in honor of this, we believe in the so-called "120 de Santa Rita" brand. After the tour, return to your hotel."

WHAT TO TAKE:

- 1 small reinforced nylon backpack to carry your belongings (photo camera, anorak, flask, etc.) during the walks;
- 1 large backpack or bag to store belongings;
- Small flashlight and extra batteries;
- 1 liter canteen or small disposable plastic bottle;
- Pre-softened hiking boots;
- 1 pair of sneakers or 1 paper bag;
- 1 anorak (nylon cover with water and wind resistant hood);
- 1 "Pile" or polar type coat;
- 2 suplex or nylon pants / 2 suplex blouse or long sleeve T-shirt;

- 1 thick wool knit;
- 1 pair of gloves and wool hat;
- 3 or 4 short-sleeved T-shirts (preferably “dryfit” fabric that does not retain water);
- 2 shorts and / or shorts;
- Socks: wool and four quarters of fiber (coolmax) for walking (avoid cotton, as it retains water);
- 1 cap and sunglasses;
- Private medicines and personal hygiene materials in small packages;
- Solar filter for face and lips;
- Moisturizer to prevent skin dryness.
